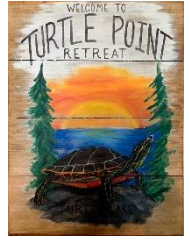

## Pontoon Rental Checklist

### ACCESS TO SOUTH TURTLE & ROCK LAKE IS PROHIBITED!

#### Before Each Use

- Pay attention to how the boat cover is installed prior to removing
- No Smoking / No Pets
- Review rental agreement for proper usage and responsibilities
- Review Lake map and be sure to avoid any hazards
- Check gas Levels – fill tank if quarter tank or less
- Cover is stowed or attached to the canopy
- Verify life jackets, fire extinguisher, and paddle are present
- Verify First aid kit/ anchors are present
- Verify all items are secure so they don't blow out while traveling
- Verify speed control lever is in neutral prior to starting**
- Review the condition of the prop
- Check for angle of wind and other boats
- Always make sure prop is in water before starting.** Tilt button can be used to adjust engine height. While traveling engine tilt should be set around 25% in the down position.
- Start engine and check fuel gauge
- No over loading boat. Keep boat balanced. Max occupancy 8 passengers
- Take it easy in Reverse– Boat engines are not designed for fast reverse operation.

#### While Traveling

- Please ensure passengers are seated, and water hazards are avoided.
- Please make sure to keep the prop in the water at all times while traveling and a constant flow of water is streaming out from side of engine. This is how boat engines are cooled
- Ensure the boat is mostly stopped before changing gears
- Stay 100 feet away or more from other boats while traveling
- Watch your depth while traveling, anything less than 3 feet of water could result in prop damage. Speeds should be slowed when in shallower waters.
- Be aware at all times of Logs, Stumps and **Rocks**

#### After Use

- Remove all Garbage
- Top off gas prior to your departure date
- Cover Boat – Cover Tag is labeled for front & back

Failure to follow boating guidelines, refill gas prior to departure or damages to boat, engine or prop could result in loss of security deposit and additional charges.
